Criteria for consideration of these awards include:

- Recruiting new people to volunteer
- Being a shining witness to Christ's presence in their lives

Nomination Process

Submit a letter of recommendation of one page that specifically describes the person's accomplishments in relation to the award criteria outlined above and why they should receive the award.

The letter must be signed by the person (the nominator). The nomination may include up to two letters of support from individuals with direct knowledge of the accomplishments of the nominee.

The submission must also include:

- the nominee's full name and contact information,
- years of membership/service with Newman and brief bio of the nominee
- the full names, titles, and contact information of the nominators
