Should I Apply?

Consider the following questions to help you discern whether the Student Campus Ministry program is right for you:

- Am I able to manage my time well?

- Can I communicate well with others, especially during time when I'm facing stress?

The Student Campus Ministry program runs from **August 22, 2020 to April 26, 2021**. Our residence fees are \$1100 per month, or \$1000 for shared accommodations, and include room and board, with either private or shared bath. **If financial concerns would prevent you from applying, speak to Erin regarding bursaries that may be available to help offset the cost.**

Students accepted to the Student Campus Ministry team share in a common life that respects their primary vocation as student while challenging them to embrace the personal growth that occurs through communal life. Students participate in shared meals, communal prayer and formation, and monthly community nights. It is our Christ-centered community that forms the basis for our ministry to other student, community members, and the wider university community.

Newman's Student Campus Ministry Team is composed of a maximum of 10 students who are attending any post-secondary education program at any institution in the GTA. Students live in private or semi-private rooms, and have a private or shared bathroom. Residence fees include food, utilities, and laundry facilities.

Student Campus Ministry are asked, above all, to come with a spirit of willingness to serve, and a desire to grow in their love of God and others. Through their experiences at Newman, students develop concrete skills that are rooted in a living relationship with Christ and help them to be leaders in the New Evangelization.



Student Campus Ministers commit to 12 hours of ministry each week, and assist with Newman's mission in three main ways:

Through service at liturgies

Student Campus Ministers assist with daily Mass during the week, as their schedule allows, and help with hospitality at either the 11 am or 7 pm Mass on Sundays. They also assist with other liturgies throughout the year.

Through contributions to community life

Student Campus Ministers participate in their team communal life through regular household duties. They also form an integral part of the larger communal life of the Newman Centre through regular participation in student groups and activities according to the interests they have and the gifts they bring to the team.

Through campus evangelization

Team members participate in spreading the Gospel on campus through orientation support, leading faith studies, taking part in Newman's discipleship program, and other activities such as adoration and board game nights, RCIA, and front desk presence.



Ministries carried out through the Newman Centre Catholic Chaplaincy are rooted in the call to relationship with Christ. Student Campus Ministers are asked to be witnesses to Christ such that their love for God and their commitment to growth in holiness draws others to Christ.

Beginning in August with the house orientation training and the leadership retreat, there are many opportunities throughout the year for team members to grow in their spiritual lives. In addition to bi-weekly team formation and frequent access to the Sacraments, students are encouraged to make personal prayer a non-negotiable daily practice.

All who become part of the Newman Student Campus Ministry family are challenged to become contagious missionary disciples who are responding wholeheartedly to God's invitation to be a Saint.
